3:35 PM. Update from Navajo DOT Roads:

- N9, from Crownpoint to Torreon has been cleared by BIA Roads.
- Breadsprings and Jones Ranch paved roads have been cleared.
- HWY 491 to Crownpoint has been cleared.
- N134, from HWY 491 to Crystal junction has been cleared.
- All Navajo Airports are clear (Chinle, Tuba City, Shiprock, Crownpoint & Window Rock)

3:00 PM. Update from Navajo DOT Roads:

- N59, from Many Farms to Kayenta has been cleared.
- N6320, from S.R. 89 to Shonto School has been cleared.
- N16, from S.R. 89 Inscription House to Navajo Mountain has been clear.
- Route N21, from Kiabeto to Tonalea has been cleared.
- N20, from Bodaway Gap to LeChee has been cleared.
- N12, from Round Rock to Navajo, NM has been cleared.
- N64, from Tsaile to Chinle has been cleared.
- N13, Lukachukai to Red Valley has been cleared.
- Buffalo Pass is NOT cleared. Still excusive snow built up.
- N12, from Chinle to Pinon has been cleared.
- N14, from Pinon to Forest Lake has been cleared.
- All paved roads in Blue Gap, Whippoorwill, and Low Mountain have all been cleared.
- All paved roads in Red Mesa, Sweetwater, Teec Nos Pos, Red Valley, Cove, and Sanostee have all been cleared.

2:00 PM. Update from Navajo DOT Roads:

- N20 from Bodaway Gap to LeChee is mostly clear, slushy in some parts.
- BIA Roads Dept. is plowing near Kaibeto

1:40 PM. Update from Navajo DOT Roads:

- Staff plowed most of Jones Ranch & Chichiltah area up until one of their trucker tire had a blow-out. This equipment is requiring repairs.
- Coyote Canyon to Mexican Springs (N30) is now clear
- Staff have just completed clearing Narbona Pass (Route 134). The Pass is now clear & open. It took a little longer to clear road due to 3 ft. plus snow drifts
- NM State DOT is still working removing snow on HWY 491 & HWY 371
- Road from HWY 491 to Crownpoint, NM is clear
- BIA Roads Dept. is still removing snow from Pinedale to Smith Lake (N4911)

- BIA Roads Dept. is nearly completed on N9 (Crownpoint to Torreon, NM)
- Staff is back at Window Rock A/P after assessing Crownpoint Airport runway.

1:05 PM. Update from Navajo DOT Roads:

- Residents wanting roads cleared to their homes.
- Once these dirt roads are cleared of snow, the possibility of heavy equipment getting stuck is high. Road is very wet and saturated underneath.
- Navajo DOT cannot clear roads to residents. Not unless NN President declares an emergency

12:30 PM. Update from Navajo DOT:

- N13 is near completion.
- Approximately 3 miles of N33, Cove area has been cleared

12:00PM. Update from Navajo DOT Roads:

- No snow accumulation in Tuba City area. Continuing assessment towards Bodaway Gap & LeChee.
- Tuba City Airport is clear of snow

11:45 AM. Update from Navajo DOT Roads:

- **N6320 (From SR 89 to Shonto School)**
- Snow has been cleared & now passable
- Staff is now moving on towards N16 from Inscription House to Navajo Mountain

Western BIA (From Kaibeto to Tonalea)

- Snow has been cleared & passable

11:30 AM. Update from Navajo DOT Roads:

- Following routes have been cleared ...
 - N12 (Lukachukai, AZ to Navajo, NM)
 - N64 (Chinle to Tsaile)
 - N59 (Many Farms to Kayenta)
 - N6320 (SR 89 to Shonto School)
- N16, Navajo Mountain area is still being cleared. Still snowing heavily says Dan Teller
- N21/N20 (Bodaway Gap to Lechee) Laborers heading there now to snowplow
- N4 (Pinon to Chinle) is clear & passable
- Working on clearing Forest Lake to Pinon

10:45 AM. Update from Navajo DOT Roads:

- Staff working on clearing Narbona Pass
- Staff in Crystal, NM area
- Staff clearing southern part of N12
- Staff clearing the northern portion of N12
- Staff working clearing most of Blue Gap roads

- Staff in Sweet Water Chapter area. Not much snow. Road is cleared
- Staff clearing Red Valley & Cove. It is still snowing heavily

9:20 AM Update:

BIA Route N27 (From Hwy 264 to Nazlini, AZ)

- Route N27 is snow packed and icy with snow accumulations of approximately 4-7 inches.
- Navajo DOT, is currently snow plowing from Hwy 264 to Nazlini.
- Snow has been cleared & passable

8:15 AM Update:

BIA Route N6 (From Hwy 264 to Indian Wells, AZ)

- Route N6 is snow packed and icy with snow accumulation of approximately 4-6 inches.
- Navajo DOT, as of 10 AM was snow plowing route N6 from Indian Wells to Hwy 264.

8:00 AM Update:

AZ Hwy 264

- Hwy 264 is snow packed and icy from MP 407 to MP 473.
 - Although, ADOT is snow plowing Hwy 264 from MP 407 to MP 473.
 - Snow accumulations ranged from 4 inches to 8 inches within the areas of Jeddito, Keams Canyon, Beshbeto, Steamboat, Ganado, and Window Rock.
