

The Navajo DOT Roads and Airports Departments continue to work on the paved road system, assisting BIA in clearing these routes.

- **Central:** *Significant accumulation from Nazlini, south to near Greasewood, up to the summit, and along the Chuskas.*
 - N4 – Chinle to Pinon is now clear.
 - N41 – Pinon to Forest Lake is now clear.
 - N8066 (Black Mesa) – From N4 to end of pavement is clear.
 - N12 – Lukachukai to Whiskey Creek is now clear.
 - N13 – Clear to the base of the mtn.
 - N27 – Nazlini removing snow and spreading cinder.
- **Western:** *Overall, clear but wet – exception was Navajo Mtn., which received 6”.*
 - N16 (Tuba City) – Pavement is wet, but clear.
 - N59 (Navajo Mtn.) – Cleared by NDOT crew this am – will receive another pass from BIA.
- **Northern:** *Wet near Shiprock. Only areas of accumulation were near Red Valley and Cove.*
 - N33 (Red Valley to Cove) – Clear.
 - N63 (Red Valley to Oak Springs) – Clear.
 - N13 – Clear to the base of the mtn. – PASS is still closed.
- **Ft. Defiance:** *Intermittent serious accumulation from Greasewood area to Summit.*
 - N15 – Dilkon to Whitecone clear
 - N6 to AZ 264 – Clear
 - N15: US89 to Burnside is clear.
 - N15: Indian wells to Dilkon
 - Sawmill area: Apache Cty II is working on county routes in the area. Will move onto Blue Canyon Road after they finish Sawmill county routes.
 - White Clay Road – Still trying to confirm if BIA has sent a blade to the road. We will mobilize there after we finish paved route commitments.
- **Eastern:** *Mainly wet.*
 - N9 to US 471 – wet, but clear
 - N9 to NM 371 – wet, but clear
 - Smith Lake to Pinedale – snow removal was conducted.
 - N48 – Borrego Pass was cleared by BIA
