The Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) is partnering with the Navajo Division of Transportation (NDOT) and Chinle and Many Farms Chapters in an effort to improve safety and travel on the US 191 corridor. The Project Study Area begins in the Chinle community at the Pinon/N4 intersection in the south and ends north of the Many Farms community. The study will recommend a program of improvement projects to address identified needs in the corridor.

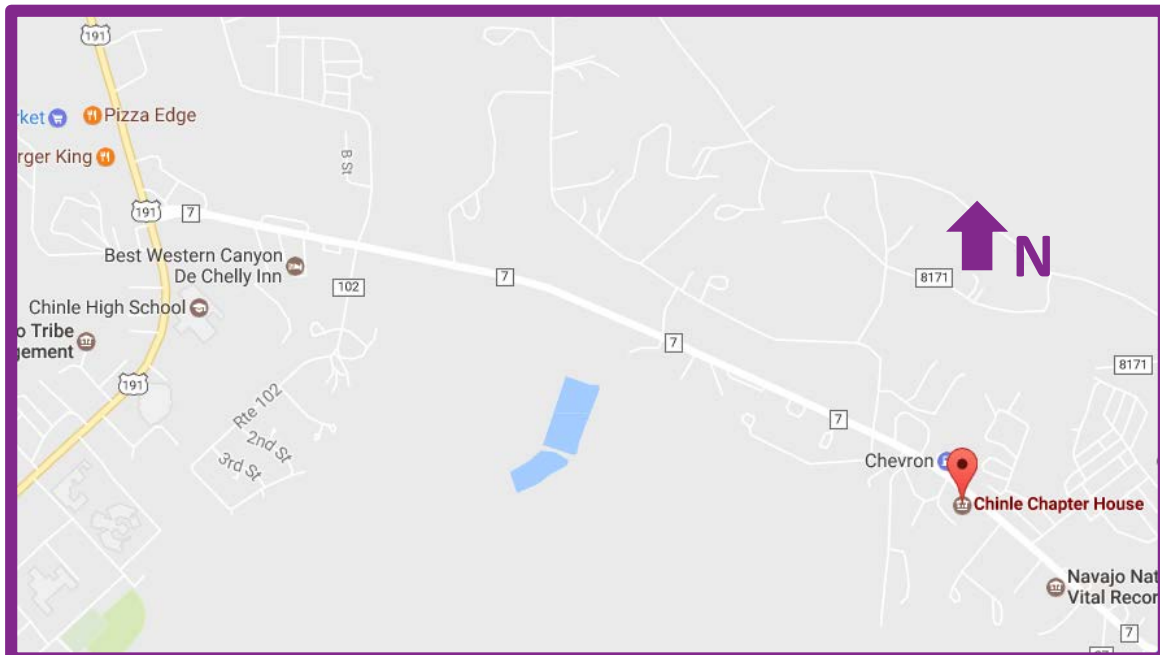
We are interested in getting your thoughts on how travel on the US 191 corridor can be improved.
